Subject: **Notice of Motion**

On September 1, 2019, amendments to the College's Act and a new regulation introduced the successful completion of a math proficiency test as a certification requirement.

Applicants for a certificate of qualification and registration who complete their application, with all supporting documents on or after March 31, 2020 will have to pass a math proficiency test. As well, current College members may also voluntarily take the math test.

In the development of the requirements and implementation of the math proficiency test, the Ministry of Education has informed the College that the successful completion of the math test will need to be reflected on a member's certificate of qualification and registration.

In anticipation of an amendment to the College's teachers' qualifications regulation, and in order to implement such a note on a member's certificate, Council will be asked to consider, at its December 5-6, 2019 meeting, the following Notice of Motion to change the College bylaws:

That Council approve the addition to the College bylaws of s. 25.01 (n), as set out below:

25.01 In addition to the information prescribed by section 23 of the Act, the register shall contain:

...

2.01(n) a statement indicating successful completion of the math proficiency test by a member, as identified to the Registrar pursuant to s. 4(7) of Regulation 271/19 of the Ontario College of Teachers Act.
